HOSTING

The web pages automatically extract and store personal data and other information in server log files that your browser transmits. Your traffic may also be stored in the US.

DURATION

Your data will be stored until further notice. With active orders, termination is only possible after fulfillment of the order, if at all possible in accordance with the reasonable effort and the goodwill of the data processors abroad¹.

Your data, stored within the EU, may be erased if requested, provided that it knows who it is stored with.

Usual obligations of the contractor:

- (1) The contractor will process data and processing results within the client's orders. If the contractor receives an official order to publish data of the client, he shall - insofar as legally permissible - inform the client without delay and refer the authority to the latter.
- (2) The contractor shall take appropriate measures to ensure the safety of the processing: technical and organizational measures.

You have the right to information, information, correction and deletion of his stored data. The extent to which this right can be exercised with foreign contractors is indefinite.

LOCATION OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF DATA PROCESSING

Data processing activities are carried out worldwide¹, at the locations of the service providers, logistics companies and suppliers, possibly during stays abroad of the managers and employees concerned.

The adequate level of data protection results from an exception for the individual case according to Art. 49 (1a) and 1b) GDPR.

Legality of processing

1. Processing shall be lawful only if at least one of the following conditions is met:

(a) the data subject has given his consent to the processing of personal data concerning him for one or more specific purposes;

(b) the processing is necessary for the performance of a contract to which the data subject is a party or for the performance of any pre-contractual action taken at the request of the data subject;

(c) the processing is necessary to fulfill a legal obligation to which the controller is subject;
